If you are not sure which hotel is closest to the events you plan to play in, I hope this information will help you. The NABC+ events will be held across the street from the three hotels in the Reno Ballroom. The Silver Legacy is directly across the street from the Reno Ballroom. The new 0-2500 NABC pairs and Swiss Team events as well as the Flight B and Flight C NAP Finals will be held in the El Dorado Convention Center. The Gold Rush, 299er games and 99er games will be held on the mezzanine level of the Silver Legacy. The regionally rated team games will be held in the lower level of the Silver Legacy. Please check your Daily Bulletin each day of the NABC because room changes for events may occur.

The most important thing that you can do PRIOR to attending the NABC is to register your vaccination information online. This will save YOU time when you arrive at the NABC. Please give yourself EXTRA TIME to complete the registration process at the NABC. You must receive your proof of vaccination PRIOR to being allowed to register for any events or collect your welcome gift bag full of goodies.
