North American Pairs (NAP) Update

Club qualifying for North American Pairs ended August 31st. Given that District 21 decided not to require Unit Level Qualification games, it has been a very quiet

period for NAP, but a couple things have happened.

First, ACBL published qualification lists for each of the three flights:

Level A Qualification List

Level B Qualification List

Level C Qualification List

Please check that you are qualified on the appropriate list(s). If you find a mistake, please send me an email at <u>icoke@yahoo.com</u> and provide a link to the club qualifying game where you qualified. Please make your link to ACBL Live because ACBL will sometimes change games after they are posted if ACBL detects irregularities and this will not be reflected on Bridgewebs, etc.

The only other thing that changed is that the District 21 Qualification games on Sunday will start at 9:30. As previously mentioned, the games will be held at the Monterey Regional in January. So, the District 21 District Level Qualification schedule becomes:

- The A level (open) District Qualifying game will be played Saturday; January 11 at 10 AM & 3 PM with approximately half the field progressing from the first day to the second day. The second day, January 12, first session will start at 9:30 AM and the second session of the day will start after a short lunch break.
- The B level (less than 2500 master points) District Qualifying game will be played Sunday, January 12 at 9:30 AM and the second session of the day will start after a short lunch break.
- The C level (less than 500 master points) District Qualifying game will be played Saturday, January 11 at 10 AM & 3 PM.
